



Join in the excitement as a volunteer at the 2022 Peyton Walker Foundation The Beat Goes On Adventure Race. All volunteers receive a free event shirt for volunteering. Volunteers will help at water stations, participant check-in, course marshaling and many other places. There are additional opportunities for those interested in helping to create the event on one of our committees.

Day of Volunteer Opportunities

Registration – Volunteers will help with the process of participants checking in. They will check if the participant is registered by last name and then give them their race materials. Some volunteers will also assist with the process of new participants signing up the day of the race.

Finisher Medal Distribution- Each participant will have a finisher medal waiting for them at the finish line. Volunteers will help set up and distribute the items.

Course Marshal – Course marshals will be placed on the course (in pairs of 2) and help direct the participants, so they run the correct way. Here we ask the volunteers to be as enthusiastic as possible encouraging the runners to have a good time.

Obstacle Volunteers - Volunteers will be located at each obstacle to ensure a fun and safe location.

Water Station – Volunteers assigned to the water station will fill up cups of water and help distribute them to passing participants.

First Aid – Work with UPMC to manage mobile first aid stations around course

Packet Pickup – Distribute race packets. This will occur the week of the race on a date, location TBD

*Volunteers will more than likely work more than one job throughout the event.

Volunteer Committee Descriptions:

Committee members are the heart of the event, planning everything from the logistics to the marketing. Some members focus on growing the event by recruiting participants and sponsors, others coordinate logistics and some work on promoting the event in the community. There's a role for everyone!

Logistics Committee Broken into 3 Subcommittees: Responsible for overseeing day-of-event logistics

Participant Experience: Managing Registration process, Packet Pick-up, overall anything that deals with participants

Volunteer Management: Help recruit volunteers, manage, and train day-of volunteers

Event Experience: Help with entertainment, non-race activities to enhance experience of all in attendance.
